In addition to Africa, Central American countries plan to increase milk production by investing in cattle breed in Brazil

Creators of Costa Rica, Panama and Nicaragua are interested in investing in Girolando to enable milk production in Central America. Importing embryos from Brazil, is considered an alternative to accelerate the genetic improvement of these herds, according to professor of the Federal University of Minas Gerais State (UFMG) and a

member of the Board Technical Girolando, Ronaldo Braga Reis. In the last October, he was in Costa Rica to attend the 20th National Congress and Milkman and presents this suggestion to the Ministry of Agriculture. "Now the frontier of Agriculture was opened, costaricans will do a good job. They have many challenges ambience (heat and humidity), but have good pasture production conditions. Since the creators adopt improvements in management practices, the Girolando can leverage local production", said Reis.

With the theme "High Production Girolando – A viable alternative to milk production – Brazilian experience", the talk by Ronaldo Reis was attend by approximately 600 people, who asked questions about the race, in the end of the talk.

The expectation is of a group of foreign visitors from Central America, participate in "Mega leite 2015" with the objective to know the dairy farming in Brazil.
